# president of the college

We asked: "Who is the Albright student? Where does he come from, but more importantly, where is he going and what is his relationship to the world around him?"

"For the most part Albright students come from Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York, and Maryland. Many students come from other parts of the United States and always some are enrolled from other countries.

Students come from all kinds of homes—rich homes, poor homes, strict homes, indulgent homes, homes where the light of educational ideals burns brightly, homes where such light is dim, homes where religion is central and homes where religion is forgotten.


Students have diverse abilities and varied talents, some well motivated and moving straight toward a clearly discerned goal, and others, lacking such motivation, aimlessly groping and wondering what college is all about.

Many students are capable of self-discipline and cooperation, but a few are aloof. Some unselfish and others untrained in the art of controlling their conduct and managing their lives. Students make drastic adjustments as they fit into a campus program, learning to live in dormitories with others who until they arrived here were total strangers, and learning to walk under the leadership of unfamiliar adults who are members of the faculty. The shock of going to college and making good as I see this transition year after year, warm one's heart and strengthen one's faith in youth."



## dean of the college

Who is he—this Albright student? Where does he come from and where is he going? An Adams, a Baker, a Borelli, a Moyer, a Zdunowski—he's a product of the American melting pot. He comes from a hundred small towns with names like Pennsauken, Hackensack, Ardmore, and Shamokin. But he comes from Philly, from New York, and some from simply the other side of Mt. Penn. He laughs, and loves; and mutters dark protests about "in loco parentis," parietal rules, and Victorian provincialism, or merely sleeps in Convocation. Some June he slips away, to Hahnemann, to Jeff, to teach in Oley, to seminary, to the university, and to Carpenter Tech. The reports in time come slowly back. He is a social worker in Harlem, the president of a seminary. He is a surgeon, a mayor, a full professor. And back on the campus one faculty member turns to another with a gleam of pride in his eye and says, "Why I remember when . . . whoever would have thought it possible?"

Opportunities for the exchange of ideas and deepening convictions should enable Albright students to increase their awareness of the needs of others so that as graduates they can better serve their communities.



John Potsklan's Lions had at least as many freshmen on the squad as upperclassmen this year. With such a young team Coach Potsklan could hardly have expected at the beginning of the season to win the Middle Atlantic Conference championship, but this year's rookies adjusted easily to college competition and filled key positions on both offense and defense.

The offense had seven freshmen in starting positions, including three in the backfield. Despite this, the offense consistently moved well and scored. Dennis Zimmerman, who had led the Lions in rushing for two consecutive seasons, won that distinction again this year. In addition, he set a new Albright record for rushing, gaining more than 1000 yards in nine games. To balance their running game, the Lions developed an effective aerial attack. Freshman Al Murray led the team in pass receptions, catching 22 Jim Strohl passes,

for a total of 285 yards. This blend of a good running game and a fine passing attack proved to be a winning combination for the Lions.

Albright's defensive squad was certainly among the best in northern division competition this season. With only one freshman starting on defense, experience was the primary ingredient that allowed only one touchdown all season in league competition, that helped intercept 18 of the opponents' passes, and that repeatedly gave the ball to the offense in good field position.

The coaching staff is unhappy to see even four men (Herb Nauss, Wayne Rogers, Don Seibert and Tom Bowersox) graduate from this team. Each one of them has been a reliable performer in the past four years. The coaches are hopeful, however, that the returning ballplayers will form the nucleus of a strong team next season.






# basketball



## track and field


